### What's the Program?

- 2 Options: 1-Week Certificate or 3-Week Intensive Program...we'll put you in a manufacturing environment.
- Career Exploration - You learn about careers such as production, engineering, management, and more.
- Skills - We teach you fundamentals to function in a shop and professional work environment safely.
- Industry - You work with teams just like the workplace to make and sell real products.
- Exposure - You're exposed to trades like carpentry, welding, machining, design, business, and operations.



### What You Learn

- This is a real work situation - we put you in the middle of quotas, deadlines, and projects.
- We teach manufacturing as you do it. That's the best way to retain learning.
- You'll manufacture real products to meet the company's demands, just like work.
- Our guides help you learn design, fabrication, quality, customer service, sales, and more.
- Students learn about pathways and skills in communication, leadership, problem-solving, and teamwork.
- We go on tours to several manufacturers to see how it's done in live settings.



### What You Earn

**1-Week Certificate** attendees receive a certificate, materials, lots of swag, and an experience of a lifetime.

**3-Week Intensive** attendees have an opportunity to earn the same as 1-week students as well as:

- **Rewards:** Earn points to spend on merchandise, school supplies, tools, gift cards, 3D printers, tech, and more.
- **Stipends:** Graduates can earn up to \$500 in stipends as they meet quotas and sell products.
- **Swag and Goodies:** We give t-shirts, materials, water bottles, pens, and a ton of stuff.
- **Experience:** This experience looks great on any resume and lets you network with professionals.
- **Skills:** Students gain knowledge and skills in tools, processes, and interpersonal skills.
- **Credit:** Some schools offer .5 elective credits for their participation. Talk to your counselor for more info.
