The Program

- 3-week program
- Participants work as teams to design, manufacture, and sell real products.
- We visit other manufacturers to see how they do things.
- Work with production professionals who give mentorship, insights, and instruction.
- Participants are exposed to welding, CNC machining, hand tools, power tools, and other processes of modern manufacturing.



What You Learn

- PMI teaches **principles and processes of production and manufacturing**.
- Learn design, fabrication, manufacturability, construction, quality, customer service, and more.
- Students are exposed to career pathways such as engineering, design, welding, production, marketing, management, and other areas.
- Gain experience using tools, working in a manufacturing environment, and preparing for work.
- Improve communication, teamwork, problem-solving, conflict, planning, and goal setting.



Earn and Learn

- **Rewards:** Students have the opportunity to earn valuable rewards, incentives, and prizes.
- **HS Credit:** Students earn .5 CTE credits for successful completion.
- **Swag and Goodies:** We bring t-shirts, materials, water bottles, and much, much more.
- **Experience:** This intensive work based learning experience looks great on any resume.
- **Skills:** Students improve knowledge and ability in tools, processes, and interpersonal skills.



Other Details

- **Schedule:** The 2024 Institute runs July 8 - 26.
- **Locations:** We anticipate at least 8 locations for 2024.
- **Interest Areas:** Great for those thinking about careers in trades.
- **May NOT Be Ideal** for those who are already well trained in a trades related program.
- **Best For:** The program seeks those who are exploring career options with interest in the trades.
- **Work Simulation:** Participants are expected to work - just like a real job. Learning comes through effort, trial, error, and application.
- **This isn't a "summer camp."** It's a live work experience with real feedback and expectations.
